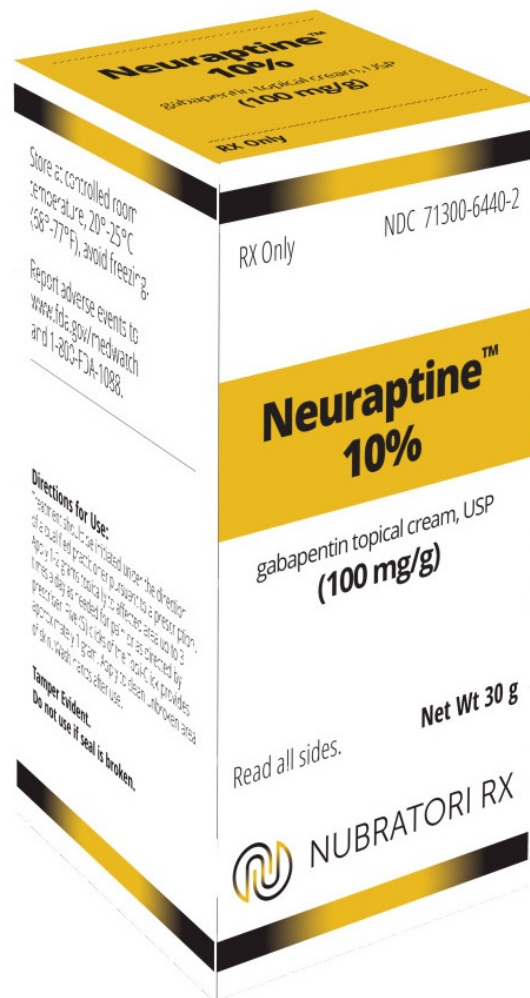

WHAT IS NEURAPTINE™?

Neuraptine™ contains gabapentin. Gabapentin is used to relieve pain.

WHAT INGREDIENTS ARE IN NEURAPTINE™?

Neuraptine™ 10% cream contains 100mg of gabapentin per gram. Neuraptine 10% cream also contains 9 mg of phenoxyethanol per gram, as preservative. The other ingredients are water, carthamus tinctorius seed oil, aloe barbadensis leaf extract, helianthus annuus seed oil, olea europaea fruit oil, butyrospermum parkii butter, beeswax, cetearyl alcohol, glyceryl stearate, perilla ocyroides seed oil, isopropyl palmitate, lysolecithin, hydrogenated lecithin, perilla ocyroides leaf extract, isopropyl myristate, squalane, punica granatum extract, tocopheryl acetate, cholecalciferol, cetyl alcohol, retinyl palmitate, vitis vinifera seed extract, wheat amino acids, triticum vulgare germ extract, oenothera biennis oil, xanthan gum, phenoxyethanol and ethyl alcohol.

WHO SHOULD NOT USE NEURAPTINE™?

Do not use Neuraptine™

- if you are allergic to any ingredient in Neuraptine™
- on skin conditions such as eczema or acne, an open or infected wound, abscess, ulcer or tumor

WHAT SHOULD I TELL MY DOCTOR BEFORE USING NEURAPTINE™?

Some medical conditions may interact with Neuraptine™. Tell your doctor if you have any medical condition or if you are taking any medications, specifically

- if you are pregnant, planning to become pregnant, or breast-feeding
- Gabapentin passes into breast milk. Consult your doctor before breast-feeding
- if you have any heart, liver, or kidney problems
- this medication may interfere with certain laboratory tests for urine protein, make sure laboratory personnel and your doctors know you are using this drug
- if you are taking any prescription, nonprescription, herbal or dietary supplements
- if you have allergies to medicines, food, or other substances

HOW SHOULD I USE NEURAPTINE™?

For external and topical use only. Treatment should be initiated under the direction of a qualified practitioner pursuant to a prescription. Apply up to 1 gram topically to affected area up to 4 times a day as needed for pain or as directed by your prescriber. 6 clicks of the Topi-Click provides approximately 1 gram. Apply to clean, unbroken area of the skin. Wash hands after use. Do not use with an air-tight or water-tight dressing (i.e. do not bandage, wrap, or cover the area with a plastic dressing).

ARE THERE ANY PRECAUTIONS I SHOULD TAKE WHILE USING NEURAPTINE™?

- Keep Neuraptine™ out of reach of children.
- Treatment should be discontinued immediately upon development of any skin reaction such as rash after application of Neuraptine™.
- Avoid contact with eyes, mouth, nose, ears, and other external orifices.
- Avoid alcohol while taking this medication.
- Report any difficulties in breathing.
- Report any suicidal or agitated behavior.
- Avoid the use in children.
- Seniors are at an increased risk of side effects and may require a lower dose.

Patients and caregivers should seek medical attention immediately if you or someone you are caring for experiences symptoms of respiratory problems, because these can be life-threatening. Symptoms to watch for include:

- Confusion or disorientation
- Unusual dizziness or lightheadedness
- Extreme sleepiness or lethargy
- Slowed, shallow, or difficult breathing
- Unresponsiveness, which means a person doesn't answer or react normally or you can't wake them up
- Bluish-colored or tinted skin, especially on the lips, fingers, and toes

WHAT ARE THE POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS OF NEURAPTINE™?

Seek emergency medical help if you have any signs of an allergic reaction, difficulty breathing, swelling of your face, lips, tongue, or throat. Less serious side effects may include temporary burning or stinging at the application site. This will usually disappear in a few days. This is not a complete list of side effects and others may occur. Report adverse events to www.fda.gov/medwatch and 1-800-FDA-1088.

HOW SHOULD I STORE NEURAPTINE™?

Store at room temperature away from heat, moisture, and light. Store at controlled room temperature, 20° to 25°C (68° to 77°F), avoid freezing. Do not store in the bathroom. Keep Neuraptine™ out of the reach of children and pets. If swallowed seek medical help or contact Poison Control Center right away.
